

Representation made by Tvl. R.S.Pandiyaraj and Rahul Balaji, Advocates

Daily Order

Dated : 15-7-2013

Learned counsel Thiru R.S.Pandiyaraj today during the court sitting made a representation for taking up the cases relating to adjustment of wind energy of consumers who own wind mills and consume wind power from it for self-use. The Hon'ble High Court's direction in a batch of Writ Petitions on the above subject matter is to dispose off this matter within a period of 30 days from the date of the Orders of the High Court. The Commission has received the Order from the High Court on various dates. Some of the Orders have been received in May, 2013 and June, 2013. A letter has also been received from the Director (Finance), TANGEDCO addressed to the Secretary, TNERC on 12th July, 2013 on the same issue. The Commission is duty bound to dispose off any matters referred to it by the Hon'ble High Court of Madras within the specified time period. However, the issues agitated by the Writ Petitioners are not known to the Commission. The Learned counsel agrees to file a petition covering all the issues agitated before Hon'ble High Court or file a copy of the writ petition itself. Liberty is granted to file a copy of the writ petition or file a separate petition as they deem appropriate. Whoever has approached the Hon'ble High Court, has liberty to approach the Commission as per the Regulations of the Commission. Similar mention was also made by Thiru Rahul Balaji, Advocate.
