DAILY ORDER

MP. No. 33 of 2012 is admitted. The petitioner argued that due to the implementation of the optimum demand concept, the industry has to operate for only 17 days and balance days being observed as holidays. He further argued that even during the working days based on energy calculated, based on the instruction of TNEB they are further subjected to power cuts or unscheduled load shedding even during working days permitted. TANGEDCO desires to take instruction for filing counter. They should file reply within 2 weeks. In the mean time TANGEDCO is directed to ensure that optimum demand concept is implemented in letter and spirit as per the Orders issued by them and ensure that unscheduled interruptions are avoided.
