*Order pronounced.*

12.20 Based on the preceding discussion and aforementioned findings, this Commission decides that the contention of the respondents that this Commission lacks inherent jurisdiction to take cognizance of the issue raised in the main petition has substance. As a corollary this Commission has to necessarily come to the irresistible conclusion that the main petition preferred by the petitioner is not maintainable under law and facts.

12.21 Accordingly the preliminary issue formulated by this Commission is decided against the petitioner.

In the result the petition preferred by the petitioner is dismissed as not maintainable under law. No order as to costs.
