**Sub:** Appointment of State Power Committee in compliance with TNERC (Forecasting, Scheduling and Deviation Settlement and related matters for Wind and Solar Generation) Regulations, 2024 and TNERC (Deviation Settlement Mechanism and related matters) Regulations, 2019 – Reconstitution of State Power Committee - Regarding.

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In exercise of the powers conferred by Regulation 18 of the TNERC (Forecasting, Scheduling and Deviation Settlement and related matters for Wind and Solar Generation) Regulations, 2024 and Regulation 15 of the TNERC (Deviation Settlement Mechanism and related matters) Regulations, 2019, the Tamil Nadu Electricity Regulatory Commission had earlier constituted State Power Committee (SPC) vide reference (1) cited.

2. Whileso, the Chief Engineer/Grid Operation, SLDC vide reference (2) cited has requested to nominate one Superintending Engineer level officer to the post of Member-Secretary of the SPC due to inter-alia of the following reasons:

- (1) TANGEDCO has already formed Secretariat for the State Power Committee vide (Per) CMD TANGEDCO Proceedings No. 9, dated 13-01-2021 under one Superintending Engineer rank officer;
- (2) Already SE/ID & REMC is holding additional charge as Member Secretary of the State Power Committee.

3. Considering the above requests of the SLDC, the State Power Committee is reconstituted consisting of the following Chairperson and Members:

4. The Committee will be reconstituted as and when any changes occur in the administrative set up of the Licensees/State owned corporations/TN SLDC. The tenure of the above members shall be three years. The Member-Secretary of the Committee shall arrange for the Committee meeting.

5. The functions of the State Power Committee will be in line with the Regulation 18 and Regulation 15 of the TNERC (Forecasting, Scheduling and Deviation Settlement and related matters for Wind and Solar Generation) Regulations, 2024 and TNERC (Deviation Settlement Mechanism and related matters) Regulations, 2019 respectively.

6. As per the provisions in the above Regulations, the SLDC shall formulate Operating Procedures and Business Rules for the State Power Committee without any delay. Non-constitution of the Operating Procedures and Business Rules by the SLDC will not in any way affect the functioning of the State Power Committee.

7. The following facilities shall be extended to the Members of the State Power Committee:

- a. The members (other than employees of the Licensees/State owned corporations/TN SLDC) shall be paid a sitting fee of Rs.3000/- (Rupees three thousand only)
- b. The outstation members shall be paid AC II class train fare as Travelling Allowance.
- c. The above expenditure shall be allowed as expenditure in the ARR of TN SLDC.

8. The meeting of the Committee shall be carried out in the manner prescribed below:

- a. Any of the members desires any change in the Regulations/Procedures/working methodology or issues in the implementation of Deviation Settlement Mechanism shall send the proposals to the Chairperson of the Committee along with the reasons for such change and detailed justification.

- b. The Member-Secretary of the panel shall upon receipt of such proposals or where the Commission has made a reference, forward the same to other members of the Committee for their suggestions/comments.
  - c. On receipt of the comments from the members of the Committee, the Member-Secretary shall arrange for the Committee meeting. Further, the Member-Secretary in consultation with the Chairperson may invite and hear any person(s) to the Committee meeting who is an expert in that particular field of subject.
  - d. The Committee after finalizing its views on the proposed modifications to the Regulations/Procedures/working methodology or issues in the implementation of Deviation Settlement Mechanism shall forward the same to the Commission, with due justification, in detail for taking final decisions.
9. The Commission may approve the changes, suggestions with or without modification as it may deem fit and cause the publication of the proposed amendment in the Regulations/procedures in such manner as may be necessary.
