IA No.18 of 2009 came up for hearing before the Commission on 3-12-2009. The Commission orally observed that the Petitioner has not justified the urgency for the grant of prayer in I.A.No.18 of 2009. The petitioner has not indicated whether the Respondent Board is willing to purchase power from the Petitioner. Pursuant to the above oral orders the Commission passes the following

Order dated 3<sup>rd</sup> December, 2009

1. Prayer of the Petitioner in I.A. No.18 of 2009:

The prayer in I.A.No.18 of 2009 is to fix the tariff for Biogas power plant of the petitioner temporarily for a minimum period of two years or till the final order with respect to Biogas plant is passed at Rs.4.50/KWH as per the comprehensive tariff order for Biomass based power plant (Order No.2 of 2009 dated 27-4-2009) without the application of Clause 9.3 (CDM benefit sharing with the respondent).

2. Findings of the Commission with reference to I.A.No.18 of 2009:

The petitioner has not justified the urgency for the grant of prayer in I.A.No.18 of 2009. Further the petitioner has not indicated whether the Respondent Board is willing to buy power from the petitioner. I.A.No.18 of 2009 is therefore dismissed. The petitioner may approach the Commission as and when an urgency arises.
