M.P. No. 14 of 2011 came up for admission before the Commission on 17-6-2011. The Commission upon perusing the above M.P. No. 14 of 2011 and other connected records and after hearing the Petitioner passes the following:-

## **ORDER**

The Commission passed an order on 7-9-2010 in D.R.P.No.4, namely, Sai Regency Power Corporation Vs TNEB. The Order of the Commission was not

implemented by the Respondent / TNEB and therefore the petitioner Sai Regency Power Corporation filed a contempt petition on 30-3-2011. TNEB (now TANGEDCO) has filed a clarificatory petition on 13-6-2011 for the same matter with the obvious intention of thwarting the contempt proceedings. This is plain and simple abuse of the process of law. If TNEB (now TANGEDCO) had genuinely wanted a clarification, the petition could have been filed within a month of the order i.e by 7-10-2010. The intentions of TNEB (now TANGEDCO) are not honourable. Further, the clarificatory petition has been filed 9 months after the order was pronounced. Certainly TANGEDCO takes things very lightly and casually.

All these issues will be addressed in the contempt petition filed by Sai Regency Power Corporation Pvt., Ltd., in M.P.No.8 of 2011. The clarificatory petition i.e M.P.No.14 of 2011 is dismissed.
