The above petition came up for arguments on 21-4-2011. During the hearing the Counsel for the petitioners submitted that Sakthi Sugars owns a generator of 35MW capacity and generates 20 MW to 30 MW of power and

supplies to TNEB. He prayed that a separate categorization in respect of coal based generators of 35 MW is required to be made so as to cover their generating plant since their plant is not covered by any Tariff Order of the Commission. After hearing both side the Commission passed the following:-

INTERIM ORDER

The Chief Engineer, TNEB in charge of IPP is directed to examine the cost of coal based generation of capacity of 35 MW and after taking into account a reasonable margin of profit recommend a tariff for this capacity within a period of 3 months. The report of the Chief Engineer may be forwarded to the Secretary to the Commission.
