1.1. The prayer in D.R.P.No.18 of 2012 is to-

- (a) direct the Respondents to accept the supply of power from the Petitioner's 1x63 MW Thermal Power Plant from the date of commissioning till the issuance of

the short term open access permissions and execution of the energy wheeling agreements for wheeling energy to the Petitioner's captive and third party consumers pending disposal of the petition ;

(b) direct the Respondents to pay the rate fixed by the Commission in its Tariff Order No.4 for the power injected into the grid by the Petitioner's 1x63 MW Thermal Power Plant from the date of commissioning till the issuance of the short term open access permissions and execution of the energy wheeling agreements for wheeling energy to the Petitioner's captive and third party consumers.

1.2. The prayer in I.A.No.1 of 2012 in the said D.R.P.No.18 of 2012 is to grant an order of interim direction to the Respondents to accept the supply of power from the Petitioner's 1x63 MW Thermal Power Plant from the date of commissioning till the issuance of the short term open access permissions and execution of the energy wheeling agreements for wheeling energy to the Petitioner's captive and third party consumers, pending disposal of the main petition.

2. The Commission upon perusing the above petition and connected records and after hearing both sides passed the following order on 18-10-2012

ORDER

I.A.No.1 of 2012 in D.R.P.No.18 of 2012 was taken up for admission. The Respondent TANGEDCO objected to filing of DRP in this matter as it should have been filed as P.P.A. petition. Reference has also been made to approval of the grid connectivity and subsequent agreements for the same. The Petitioner informed that by letter dated 17-10-2012, TANTRANSCO has taken note of the program of the company to synchronize the unit to the grid on 17-10-2012. The Petitioner shall

exhaust the remedy as available to him by dealing with TANGEDCO and the TANTRANSOCO / SLDC, as the case may be, and if need arises an appropriate petition may be filed before the Commission. The present I.A. petition along with D.R.P.No.18 of 2012 is disposed of.
