1. M.P.No.2 of 2012 and I.A.No.1 of 2012 were filed on 15-02-2012. They were taken on file on 21-02-2012 and the Counsel for the Petitioner prayed two weeks time for arguments. The time was granted by the Commission and the above case is adjourned on the request of the Petitioner. In the meanwhile, the Counsel for the Petitioner in letter dated 23-04-2012 has stated that a Writ Petition No.7933 of 2012 was filed by M/s.Chennai Petroleum Corporation Limited before the Hon'ble High

Court of Madras and interim orders have been issued by the Hon'ble High Court of Madras and as such the Petitioner has requested for withdrawing the above M.P. No.2 of 2012. As per Clause 20 (10) of the Tamil Nadu Electricity Regulatory Commission – Conduct of Business Regulations, 2004, if the Commission admits a petition it may give such order and direction as may be deemed necessary for service of notices to the Respondent and other affected or interested parties for the filing of replies to the petition. Since in the instant case the above petition has not been admitted and no notice to the Respondent has been served, orders may be passed in permitting the Petitioner to withdraw the petition.

2. It is not necessary to post this petition for hearing and it is open to the Commission to pass the orders permitting the withdrawal of the petition. The following order is passed:-

**ORDER**

3. The Counsel for the Petitioner in letter dated 23-04-2012 prayed for granting permission to the Petitioner to withdraw the above petition M.P. No. 2 of 2012, since Writ Petition No.7933 of 2012 was filed by the Petitioner before the Hon'ble High Court of Madras and interim orders pursuant to that have also been issued by the Hon'ble High Court of Madras. The Petitioner is accordingly permitted to withdraw the above petition No. M.P. No.2 of 2012 and I.A. No.1 of 2012 in MP No. 2 of 2012.
