1. M.P.No.1 of 2012 came up for admission before the Commission on 16-02-2012. The Commission after hearing the Learned Counsel for the Petitioner passed the following Interim Order:-

**INTERIM ORDER**

Thiru.P.H.Vinod Pandian, Standing Counsel for the Petitioner was present. Heard the Learned Standing Counsel for the TANGEDCO. The Learned Standing Counsel admitted that if the prayer in the petition is admitted it will affect other parties also. Therefore, he was directed to implead other necessary parties, Government of Tamil Nadu, TEDA and TANTRANSKO.

2. The above petition came up for hearing on 18-10-2012. The Commission on 18-10-2012 passes the following final order:-

**FINAL ORDER**

M.P.No.1 of 2012 was filed by TANGEDCO in February 2012 for dispensing with the banking provision to wind energy generation for existing and future wind projects. This petition was heard on 16-02-2012. The TANGEDCO was directed to implead other necessary parties, namely, Government of Tamil Nadu, TEDA and TANTRANSCO. This is not done so far. In the meantime, the Commission has issued the Tariff Order for wind energy on 31<sup>st</sup> July 2012 in which certain changes to the banking provisions to wind energy have been incorporated. In view of non-prosecution of the petition and also in view of the changes to banking provisions in the latest Tariff Order for Wind Energy, this petition is not admitted. In case TANGEDCO so desires, they may file a fresh petition. The fees paid in respect of M.P.No.1 of 2012 would be adjusted in case TANGEDCO comes with a fresh petition on the same issue. Accordingly M.P.No.1 of 2012 is disposed of.
