**ORDER**

Tamil Nadu Transmission Corporation Limited (TANTRANSCO) filed the Tariff Petition for Transmission Tariff for MYT Period 2013-14 to 2015-16 on 19.2.2013 along with I.A. No.1 of 2013 for condonation of delay of 81 days. Thiru. S. Sekkizhar, Director (Finance), TANTRANSCO was present. I.A. No.1 of 2013 in T.P. No.2 of 2013 regarding condonation of delay was taken up first. Director (Finance), TANTRANSCO explained that after unbundling they have been experiencing some difficulties with regard to staff. They have to collect the details of capital expenditure from 24 circles. They have completed the audit of accounts for the financial year 2010-11. They have also prepared the provisional accounts for the year 2011-12 and the same is being audited by the statutory auditors. Further they had to arrive at the allotted transmission capacity for the purpose of

arriving at the transmission charges for different class of users. Under these circumstances he pleaded for condonation of delay of 81 days for filing the petition.

2. The Commission had directed TANTRANSCO on 8.1.2013 to file the ARR Petition without any further delay as they had not filed the Petition by the due date of 30<sup>th</sup> November 2012. This was followed up by a reminder on 21.1.2013. They were further advised to expedite the filing of the Petition by another letter dated 8.2.2013. The Petition was eventually filed on 19.2.2013. After perusing the reasons in the I.A. and the additional submissions made during the hearing, the Commission condones the delay of 81 days in filing this petition and admits T.P. No.2 of 2013.

3. The abridged version of the tariff proposal which is due for publication in news papers shall be submitted to the Commission by 25.2.2013 and the same will be approved by the Commission by 28.2.2013.

4. The approved abridged version may be published in two English and two Tamil news papers having wide circulation on 2.3.2013. Views and suggestions of the stake holders on the tariff proposal may be invited upto 2<sup>nd</sup> April 2013. The tariff petition of TANTRANSCO both in English and Tamil shall be posted on the website of the TANTRANSCO as well as TNERC for the information of all stake holders.

5. The copies of the tariff petition will also be made available for sale at a price of Rs.200/- per copy from 2<sup>nd</sup> March 2013 in all offices of Regional Chief Engineers and Transmission Circles of TANTRANSCO besides the Head Quarters.

6. The Commission further directs TANTRANSCO to file the Petition in future as per the due date stipulated in the Regulations.
