The prayer of the petitioner in M.P.No.46 of 2010 is to direct the respondent for implementation of the comprehensive tariff order for wind power dated 20-03-2009.

2. In the hearing held on 03-12-2010, the Commission has passed the following orders:-

“The petition for enforcement of Tariff Order No.1 of 2009 was taken up. The tariff order was dated 20-03-2009 and the Indian Wind Power Association filed petition for enforcement of the tariff order on 09-11-2010. nearly after 20 months. The Commission considers that it is a belated petition.

The tariff order has been challenged in the Appellate Tribunal for Electricity by the then TNEB and the arguments are in progress. At this stage, it would not be proper to take up this petition for enforcement. The petitioner may submit before APTEL the irretrievable benefits which would be lost by them, if the order is not enforced forthwith.

The petition may be kept pending and taken up after the disposal of the appeal by the APTEL”.

3. In the hearing held on 07-02-2013, Thiru Rahul Balaji, Learned Counsel for the petitioner did not press the petition. The Commission upon perusing the records and after hearing both sides passed the following order on 07-02-2013:-

ORDER

Counsel for both sides were present. Thiru Rahul Balaji, Learned Counsel did not press the petition. Therefore, the petition is dismissed as withdrawn.
