The petitioner has prayed to direct the respondents not to levy and collect the backup power or outage charges from the direct consumers of the respondent Board

who purchase power from the petitioner to compensate the power shortage. The above case came up for hearing on the question of maintainability of the petition. The Commission upon hearing both parties and after perusing the relevant record passes the following order:-

**ORDER**

The dispute raised by the petitioner is basically between the consumer and the licensee and it would not fall under the jurisdiction of this Commission. Moreover, the affected consumers had not submitted the petition. The generator has no locus standi in this case. The case is to be dealt with by the Consumer Grievance Redressal Forum of the concerned circle. The petition is disposed off accordingly.
