1. P.R.C.No.4 of 2017 has been filed with a prayer to-
 - (i) set aside the directions in Lr.No.SE/VEDC/VPM/AEE/GL/TA/F.EHT Sc 6&59/D.247 & 248/16, dated 01.06.2016 issued by the Fourth Respondent and consequently direct TANGEDCO to permit the Petitioner to use the existing 0.2 class ABT meters installed in their generating plants inasmuch as it complies with the regulatory requirements or in the alternative permit the Petitioner to procure and supply its own 0.2S class ABT meter suitable for their industry operations inasmuch as it complies with the regulatory requirements and direct the TANGEDCO not to insist upon using the meter proposed to be supplied by TANGEDCO as it lacks certain technical requirements of the Petitioner's Generating Plants which in turn is detrimental to the interest of the Petitioner;
 - (ii) pass an ex-parte ad interim order and/or grant interim relief of the Lr.Nos.SE/VEDC/VPM/AEE/GL/TA/F.EHT SC 6 & 59/D.247 & 248/16, dated 01-06-2016 issued by the 4th Respondent herein pending disposal of this petition; and
 - (iii) pass such other and further orders, as the Commission deems fit and proper in the facts and circumstances of the case.

2. The above P.R.C.No.4 of 2017 came up for hearing on 29-08-2017. The Junior Counsel of Thiru Rahul Balaji representing the Petitioner prayed the Commission to permit them to withdraw the case.

3. The Commission upon perusing the records and considering the prayer of Petitioner passes the following order:-

ORDER

P.R.C.No. 4 of 2017 was taken up for hearing on 29-08-2017. The Junior Counsel of Thiru Rahul Balaji representing the Petitioners prayed the Commission to permit them to withdraw the case. The prayer is allowed and accordingly P.R.C.No.4 of 2017 is dismissed as withdrawn.
