The above M.P. No.7 of 2020 has been filed with a prayer to approve and ratify the dispatch of power made from BBGTPS and M/s.TAQA during the 3rd quarter from 01-10-2019 to 31-12-2019 of the financial year 2019-20 (399.24 MU) as mentioned in the Table in Para 10 of the petition. During the hearing on 10-03-2020, the petitioner has filed a Memo with a prayer to withdraw the said Miscellaneous Petition. In the said Memo, the petitioner has submitted the following:-

“M.P. No.7 of 2020 is filed by the petitioner before this Commission relying on the following directives of this Commission:-

Para 7.1.1. (g) of the Tariff Order dated 11-08-2017 reads as follows:

“To take prior approval from the Commission for purchasing from unapproved sources.”

Further, vide Table 4-52, this Commission approved the Power Purchase Expenses for the FY 2018-19. In the said table, this Commission approved only fixed charges to M/s. TAQA and not variable charges. Since the variable charges are not approved to M/s. TAQA this petitioner construed that this plant is unapproved source and filed this M.P. No.7 of 2020.

It is stated that in the order dated 11-08-2017 in T.P. No.1 of 2017, this Hon’ble Commission has approved the Merit Order Ranking for the available sources of power for the FY 2018-19 vide Table 4-49. In the said MOD Ranking for FY 2018-19, this Hon’ble TNERC included STCMS – Neyveli (now M/s. TAQA, IPP).

Further, in para 4.15.5 of the Tariff Order, this Hon’ble TNERC clarified that in cases where the sources have been considered as partial / zero despatch in the Merit Order Dispatch, the fixed costs have been considered fully, assuming that they will meet the availability norms as per the PPA / Regulations. The Commission further ordered that the actuals to be trued-up. Hence, the dispatches made from M/s.TAQA are approved sources and to be trued-up in the subsequent ARR to be filed by the petitioner. Hence, no separate petition needs to be filed by the petitioner for dispatching M/s. TAQA for the FY 2019-20.

Considering the above submissions, permission may be granted by the Commission to withdraw M.P. No.7 of 2020 as unnecessary in the light of the facts set out above.”

The Commission upon perusing the records and after hearing the submission of the petitioner passes the following

ORDER

The Petitioner is permitted to withdraw the petition. Accordingly, the petition is dismissed as withdrawn.
