



TAMIL NADU ELECTRICITY REGULATORY COMMISSION

Draft Notification No.TNERC/TR/5/2- dated -06-2017 (Comments invited by 08-06-2017)

The following draft of amendment to the Tamil Nadu Electricity Regulatory Commission (Terms and Conditions for determination of Tariff) Regulations, 2005, which it is proposed to make in exercise of the powers conferred by section 181 read with section 61 of the Electricity Act, 2003 (Central Act 36 of 2003) and all other powers enabling it in this behalf, is hereby published for information of all persons likely to be affected thereby, as required by sub-section (3) of section 181 of the said Act.

2. Notice is hereby given that the draft amendment will be taken into consideration after the expiry of fifteen days from the date of publication of this Notification in the TNERC website and that any objection or suggestion, which may be received from any person before the expiry of the aforesaid period will be considered by the Commission.

DRAFT AMENDMENT

In the said Regulations, in Regulation 11, for sub-regulation (2), the following sub-regulation shall be substituted, namely:-

"The time between 06.00 hours and 09.00 hours and between 18.00 hours and 22.00 hours shall be treated as peak hour"

EXPLANATORY STATEMENT

As per sub-regulation (2) of regulation 11 of the Tamil Nadu Electricity Regulatory Commission (Terms and Conditions for the determination of Tariff Regulations, 2005, the time between 06.00 hours and 09.00 hours and between 18.00 hours and 21.00 hours is the peak hour. It is noticed that the load in the system is too high even between 21.00 hours and 22.00 hours. TANGEDCO in its Petition for adjustment of Tariff for FY 2017-18 also requested for change of Time of the Day Tariff. In order to reduce demand during the period from 18.00 hours to 22.00 hours by encouraging the drawal of power during off peak hours, it has been decided to amend sub-regulation (2) of the said regulation 11 suitably and to implement the Time of the Day Tariff accordingly.

2. The amendment seeks to achieve the above object.
